Please be aware that the hall is open from 9-12 noon each day. There will not be anyone there to accept applications after noon. Plan accordingly so that your application is turned in on time.

The applicant will be graded according to the values below:

SECTION 1: SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY - 25% of total score

List school activities, programs, sports, leadership positions and community activities you have been involved in and when or how long you were involved.

SECTION 2: CHURCH INVOLVEMENT - 25% of total score

List any church programs or activities you have been involved in and when or how long you were involved.

SECTION 3: ESSAY QUESTION - 50% of total score

Respond fully to the following question and do not include any specific activities from section 1 and 2.

Requirements:

1. Each applicant must submit a typed essay addressing the question. Essay must be at least 300 words and no more than 500 words, double spaced, size 12 font: Times, New Roman, or Arial. Please send 4 copies of the essays for judges to read and be sure photocopies are legible. Essays that are illegible or hand written will be disqualified.
2. The applicant must not mention his/ her name or make any other identifying reference within or on the essay. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.

ESSAY QUESTION

When you choose a college, you will join a new community of people who have different backgrounds, experiences, and stories. What is it about your background, your experiences, or your story that will enrich your college community?

SECTION 1: SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY- List school activities, programs, sports, leadership positions and community activities you have been involved in and when or how long you were involved.

SECTION 2: CHURCH INVOLVEMENT- List any church programs or activities you have been involved in and when or how long you were involved.

SECTION 3: ESSAY QUESTION- Answer the question the following question in 300-500 words: The lessons we take from *obstacles we encounter* can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a *challenge, setback, or failure*. How did it affect you, and how did your faith help you learn from the experience?
